First-Ever-in-Oklahoma Property Search Tools ARE HERE!

NEW County APP is the Best Way to Access New Features

“The new features at the Oklahoma County Assessor’s webpage are the first-ever for any county in Oklahoma and could be among the most powerful real estate search tools ever offered anywhere,” explained Larry Stein chief deputy for Oklahoma County Assessor Leonard Sullivan.

“How would you like to find ALL the one-story homes sold or with ownership transferred in Oklahoma County in 2017? How about searching for vacant or improved land transactions by city or unincorporated areas of the county? Would that help those trying to find particular types of real estate? How about finding all the sales or transfers of property involving car washes, apartments, storage facilities, two-story homes or split levels? You can set up your own searches for all types of properties on some just-released features on the ever-improving assessor’s web page,” Stein said.

“The best way to get to the most up-to-date information and use these amazing new search tools for property in Oklahoma County is to download the county app. With the more than 330,000 parcels in the entire 720 square miles that make up Oklahoma worth more than \$7 Billion, the Oklahoma County Application added to your desktop or your phone is the best way to find property information. The app now works with any iPhone or android and you can get to maps and aerial images and enlarge them with your touch screen, something that was only available on android phones before,” Stein explained.

“Last year more than 13 million people visited the assessor’s page and we hope with more people using the mobile app, we can raise those numbers,” Stein said.

In addition to the Assessor’s page, the app will also provide links to all the other county offices, meeting notices, agendas, video recordings of many meetings and other information that may be more difficult to search for through your current computer browser.
