Database 'Crash Course'

OK CO Assessor and Moore-Norman Technology Center Teams Up

Have you ever wondered how many one-story or two-story homes have sold in an Oklahoma County city or zip code in the past year? Have you ever sought information regarding sales or transfers of property involving apartments, storage facilities or car washes? If so, the Oklahoma County Assessor's Office has that information available online, free of charge, 24 hours a day, seven days a week FREE OF CHARGE, Oklahoma County Assessor Larry Stein said.

"While the new features are available free on the website, most visitors to the Oklahoma County Assessor's Office webpage may be unaware of the new features. The assessor's office was invited by the Moore-Norman Technology Center to offer a 'crash course' March 7, 2019 from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. on how to use the new app's database," Stein said. Contact Ernie Gomez to make reservations at (405) 801-5000 the cost is \$20 and includes box lunch.

"Access to the assessor's website is free, but this sponsored meeting, including lunch, is \$20 and is available to anyone interested in real estate including residential and commercial realtors and the public. Real estate experts from the Oklahoma County Assessor's Office will conduct the crash course," Stein said.

"We always urge those folks who attend our Web-Ucation classes to visit with us about what you want to do on the website. There may be a way to accomplish the task and this 'Crash Course' provides a great venue to get the answers you need where we can walk you through the solutions to questions," Stein said.

"We are excited to offer to the public and professionals a new property transaction search engine that offers database information they've never had access to before," Stein said. "Few jurisdictions have this kind of information anywhere in the state and perhaps in the country," he said.

The 90-minute crash course is planned for March 7, from 11:30 a.m. until 1:00 p.m., at the Moore-Norman Technology Center, located at 13301 S Pennsylvania Ave, in Oklahoma City.

"The Oklahoma County Assessor's website logs more than 13 million users each year and having this new information available to anyone using a smart phone gives realtors and the public more power by having useful information in the palm of their hands," Stein said.
